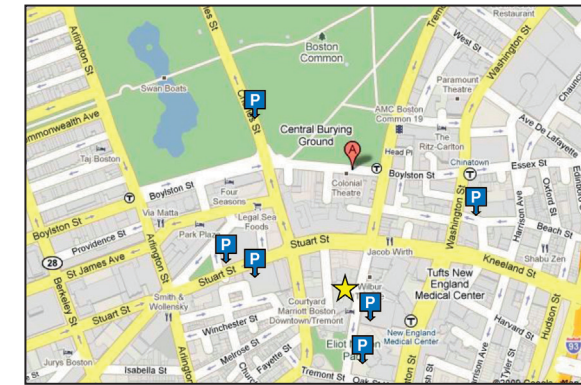

From I-93 North

Take Exit 20A toward South Station. Merge onto Purchase Street and continue on Surface Road. Take a right on Kneeland Street and continue on Stuart Street. Take a left on Tremont Street. Hotel will be on the right.

From I-93 South

Take Exit 20 Toward South Station. (When you get off the exit, it looks like you bear right at the first split and bear left on the second split.) Continue straight onto Lincoln Street. Take a left at the second set of lights onto Kneeland Street. Kneeland Street becomes Stuart Street. Take a left onto Tremont Street. Hotel will be on the right 100 yards down.

From I-90 West (Massachusetts Turnpike)

Take Exit 22 toward Prudential Center/Copley Square. Stay to the right, following the signs to Copley Square. At the end of the ramp, continue onto Stuart Street. Bear right at the fork at the upcoming intersection. Take a right onto Tremont Street. Hotel will be on the right 100 yards down.
