

## DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

### Directions

#### From Points North or South

Take I-95 North or South to Exit 22A, Memorial Boulevard, in Providence. Memorial Boulevard becomes Dyer Street. Continue down Dyer Street for approximately three-tenths of a mile. Then turn right onto Ship Street. Take your first left onto Richmond Street. Our building will be located immediately on your left.

#### From Points East

Take I-195 West to the Point Street Exit (Exit #1A). Take a sharp right onto Point Street. After approximately, two-tenths of a mile, turn left onto Richmond Street. The medical school building is located at 222 Richmond Street, approximately two-tenths of a mile down on your right.

### Conference Location and Parking

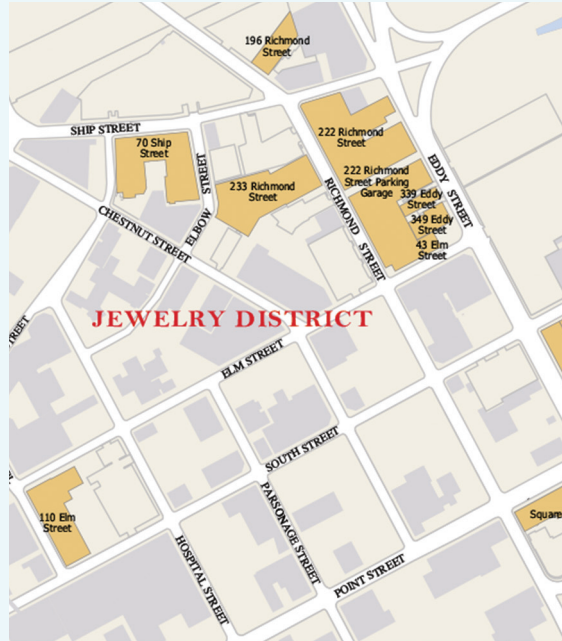
