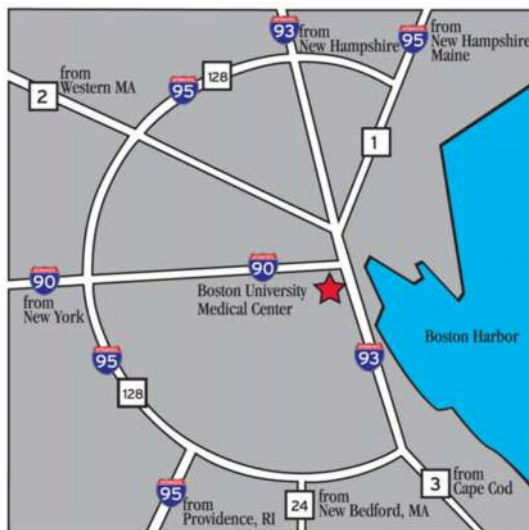

DIRECTIONS

- **From the North:** Take Route 93 South (If coming from Route 1, follow Route 1 South (Via Mystic/ Tobin Bridge) to Route 93 South). Take Exit 18 (Mass Ave). At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Massachusetts Ave. Take second right onto Harrison Avenue Boston Medical Center/Harrison Avenue campus is the first driveway on your right.
- **From the South:** Take Expressway North (Route 93 / 3). Take Exit 18. At the third traffic light, take left onto access road stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Massachusetts Ave. Take second right onto Harrison Avenue Boston Medical Center/Harrison Avenue campus is the first driveway on your right.
- **From the West:** Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) East to end. Take Expressway South (Route 93). Take Exit 18 (Mass Ave). At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in the right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Massachusetts Ave. Take second right onto Harrison Avenue Boston Medical Center/Harrison Avenue campus is the first driveway on your right.

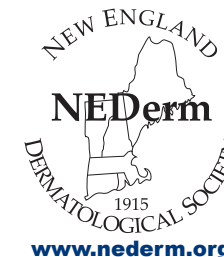
