Directions

• From the North

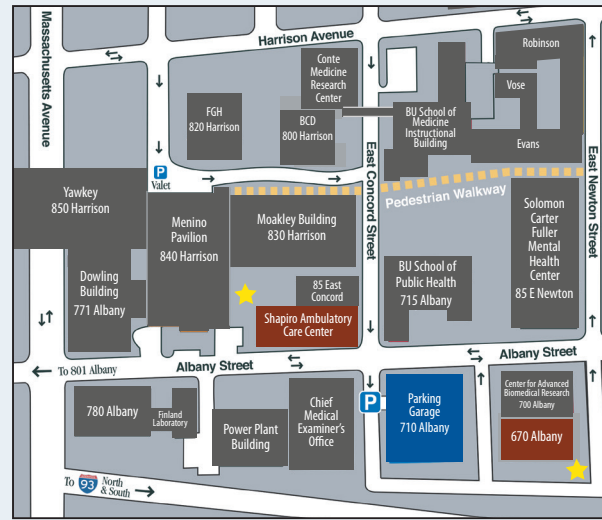
Take Route 93 South; you can access this highway from Route 1 South. Take Exit 18 (Massachusetts Avenue). At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in right lane. At the end of access road, turn right onto Massachusetts Avenue. Turn right onto Albany Street; the Shapiro Ambulatory Care Center will be on your left. To access the parking garage, turn right onto East Concord Street; entrance to garage is on left.

• From the South

Take Expressway North (Route 93/3). Take Exit 18. At the third traffic light, take left onto access road; stay in right lane. At end of access road, turn right onto Massachusetts Avenue. Turn right onto Albany Street; the Shapiro Ambulatory Care Center will be on your left. To access the parking garage, turn right onto East Concord Street; entrance to garage is on left.

• From the West

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) East to the end. Take Expressway South (Route 93). Take Exit 18 (Mass Ave). At traffic light, take right onto access road; stay in the right lane. At the end of access road, turn right onto Massachusetts Avenue. Turn right onto Albany Street; the Shapiro Ambulatory Care Center will be on your left. To access the parking garage, turn right onto East Concord Street; entrance to garage is on left.
